Nueva conexión de easyJet desde Gibraltar a Londres

El primer servicio a Londres Luton vuela hoy

Gibraltar, 4 de diciembre de 2018

La aerolínea easyJet ha celebrado el comienzo de su nuevo servicio entre Gibraltar y el aeropuerto de Londres Luton.

El primer vuelo llegó a Gibraltar desde Londres Luton a las 15:50 con 125 pasajeros a bordo.

El nuevo servicio operará dos veces a la semana durante el año, los martes y los sábados, mediante una aeronave Airbus A319, y los billetes tendrán un precio inicial de 15,72 libras*.

El aeropuerto de Londres Luton se une a los de Bristol, Londres Gatwick y Mánchester en el marco de la red de rutas de easyJet desde Gibraltar.

Ali Gayward, Responsable de País para el Reino Unido de easyJet, comentó:

“Estamos encantados de haber operado el primer vuelo de este nuevo servicio hoy y de estar incrementando nuestros servicios desde Gibraltar.

Se trata del cuarto servicio al Reino Unido de nuestra red gibraltareña y seguimos observando un aumento en el número de viajeros que buscan volar con easyJet en nuestras rutas a Gibraltar.

Al ofrecer tarifas asequibles y un tiempo de vuelo de algo más de dos horas y media, estamos seguros de que el nuevo servicio a Londres Luton resultará popular con viajeros tanto de negocios como de ocio.

Mantenemos nuestro firme compromiso de servir a Gibraltar y apoyar el crecimiento del turismo y los negocios mediante nuestras tarifas sencillas y asequibles”.

easyJet commences new London connection from Gibraltar

- **First service to London Luton flies today**

easyJet has celebrated the commencement of its new service between Gibraltar and London Luton.

The first flight arrived into Gibraltar from London Luton at 15:50 with 125 passengers onboard.

The new service is operating twice weekly year round on Tuesdays and Saturdays on an Airbus A319 aircraft with fares starting from £15.72.

London Luton joins Bristol, London Gatwick and Manchester on easyJet's route network from Gibraltar.

Ali Gayward, easyJet's UK Country Manager said:

"We're delighted to have operated the first flight of this new service today and to be increasing our services from Gibraltar.

"This is a fourth UK service to our network from the airport and we continue to see an increased number of travellers looking to fly with easyJet on our Gibraltar routes.

"With affordable fares and flight time of just over two and a half hours, we're confident that this new service to London Luton will prove popular with both business and leisure travellers.

"We remain fully committed to serving Gibraltar and supporting the growth of tourism and business through our easy and affordable fares."

"We warmly welcome easyJet's new London Luton service, which will cater for the north London region and beyond."
